







Number of Researchers in Top 15 Research Categories












Sector Overview: Ottawa's Life Sciences Clusters








Ottawa and Eastern Ontario Companies by Sector Grouping, 2003

Ottawa and Eastern Ontario Company Employment by Cluster Grouping, 2003








Ottawa and Eastern Ontario Health-Related Organizations, 2003
